

The Graduate Nursing Program at Georgia Southern University accepts either the Graduate Record Examination (GRE) or the Miller Analogy Test (MAT) for admission purposes. These tests may be taken at any site. Official scores must be sent directly to Graduate Admissions at Georgia Southern University PO Box 8113, Statesboro, GA 30460 from the testing agency. Student copies of test scores are not accepted by the Admissions Office. Please see the admission criteria for acceptable scores. Information on the GRE and MAT is noted below.

## **Graduate Record Examination (GRE )**

Persons registering for the computerized GRE General Test or Writing Assessment will be sent a free CD-ROM of ETS's popular POWERPREP 2.0 software.. A downloadable version of POWERPREP will also be available for free to test registrants and non-registrants alike, via the GRE Web site, <http://www.gre.org>.

The POWERPREP software features:
