**Georgia Southern University Application**

Admission to Georgia Southern University through the office of Undergraduate Admissions is required prior to consideration for admission to the RN-BSN / RN-MSN Programs.

**New Students**

1. Go to the Office of Admissions Homepage at <http://admissions.georgiasouthern.edu/> to apply online (see link on right side of page) and to check on the status of your application.
2. Request transcripts from all colleges attended to be sent directly to Georgia Southern's Admissions Office.
3. Send your Certificate of Immunization located at <http://www.aux.georgiasouthern.edu/health/imm.php> to Health Services (keep a copy for the School of Nursing).

**Former Students**

1. Go to the Registrar's Homepage at <http://students.georgiasouthern.edu/registrar/> to apply as a former student (see "Former Student Application" under "Forms Online" (right side of page)).
2. Request transcripts from all colleges attended since last attendance at Georgia Southern to be sent directly to Georgia Southern's Registrar's Office.
3. Send your Certificate of Immunization located at <http://www.aux.georgiasouthern.edu/health/imm.php> to Health Services (keep a copy for the School of Nursing).

**School of Nursing Application**

1. RN-BSN / RN-MSN application (including Georgia RN license number)
2. School of Nursing Student Health Appraisal
3. Copy of Georgia Southern Health Services form
4. CPR Certification (American Heart Association Level C)
5. Copy of Face Sheet of Liability Insurance
6. Signed Verification of Health Insurance Form (check forms link)

7. Signed Authorization for Release of Records and Information form (check forms link)
8. Signed Student Applied Learning Experience Agreement form (check forms link)

**Orientation**

An all-day Saturday orientation is held each fall and spring for new RN-BSN / RN-MSN students. Students are expected to attend the session, which substitutes for SOAR orientation provided by the Admissions Office.
