Admission Requirements

1. Admission to Georgia Southern University.
 2. Total institution GPA of 2.75 or better on all course work, including transfer work.
 3. Completion of a minimum of 15 semester hrs. and enrolled in at least 12 semester hrs. at time of application (4 hrs. in Area D and/or F).
 4. Completed KINS 2531/2511 and KINS 2532/2512 with a C or better (no later than Summer Term B of application year).
 5. A grade of C or better on all work in Areas D & F.
 6. Completed, by deadline, an Application package that includes the following:
 - A) Application form, B) College transcripts, C) Blood borne pathogen training, D) Documented observation hours in an approved athletic training room environment, E) Writing sample, F) Three letters of recommendation, and G) Personal interview.
 - B) Applications are available in the Student Services Center or in Susan Wehring's office, Director of the AT Education Program, Hollis Bldg, Room #1101B.
- ◆ **Guided Major Electives:** Advisor approved electives. See advisor for a list of course options.
 - ◆ Student is responsible for any prerequisites for elective classes; prerequisite credit hours may be in addition to those required by program of study.
 - ◆ Students may elect to sub PHYS 2211 for PHYS 1111 with advisor approval.
